We applaud the government initiative to establish 7 new crime units for the fight against drugs. Financial support beyond the current fiscal year, monitoring progress and attention given to social challenges emerging from the disruption of drug circulation will be part of cities' focus.

We also appreciate your commitment in not imposing timeline on discussions surrounding regional policing. As you mentioned, in the context of the current municipal reform and in respect of communities, some will need more time than others to explore the opportunity.
